The simple fact is that if my family hadn't been able to access this free specialist care, my Dad would've most likely been admitted to hospital rather than receiving care in the comfortable surroundings of his own home. For this I will be forever grateful.

I hope by telling my family's story you can see the difference your support for St. Margaret's Hospice has made to the lives of local people affected by life-limiting illness. Their incredibly dedicated team touches the lives of over 2000 patients every year but with your continuing support other families like mine will have access to St. Margaret's specialist care when they need it most.
